The MassHealth Personal Care Attendant (PCA) program helps consumers who need support with activities of daily living (e.g., walking, bathing, etc.) to live independently in their homes. Through the <u>Mass PCA</u> <u>Directory</u> job seekers are matched to consumer-employers in need of services.
